Community Christmas Food Basket

- Laville Elementary School will collect the food again this year.
- Lakeville Lions will pick up food at the school on November 18 at 9:00 a.m.
- Food will be taken to the Union/North EMS Building to be sorted.
- Distribution of food and toys on December 17 from 8:00 a.m. – Noon.
- Lakeville Lions will provide half a ham with each basket.
- In 2004, we gave out 31 baskets and about 110 toys.
- The Laville Schools and the Union Township Trustee will provide the family names.

Toys for Tots

- Toys for Tots drive from November 14 to December 18.
- Lakeville “Blitz Day” on December 10 at Lion Dave Grenert’s garage from 7:30 a.m. to Noon.
- Toys for Tots boxes will be at: Gift Basket Express, Dave Grenert’s garage, Newton Center (Old Lakeville School).
- The Marine Corps will bring extra toys to add to the toys we collect, so we can give each child 3 or 4 toys this year.
