We served 275 people. The numbers aren't final, but the net profit will be about \$1,100. We will give \$500 to the **Lakeville Volunteer Fire Department**, which when added to the \$600 we gave them in advance will total \$1,100 for the pur-

chase or repair of Christmas decorations for the town of Lakeville.

Next — Annual Fish Fry, Friday, April 6, 2012. Your support and especially your help is expected. Become a member of the "Fish Fry Crew" under the leadership of Captain Max and 1st Mates Bob and Vic.

The **Lakeville Volunteer Fire Department** presented the Lakeville Lions Club with a check for \$560 from the proceeds of the Fire Department's Chili Supper. They are a community partner In supporting the "Blessings in a Box" project. This donation will provide 16 families with quality and nutritious food they may not have had. The **Sons of the American Legion**, the **Lapaz Lions Club**, and other members of our community are also partners in this effort. Community organizations and community members working together make for a caring community. Past President Lion Howard Heines often stated it well: "This is a community effort—we all stand tall in our compassion for our fellow man".

Indiana Tornado Relief: One day after the tornado hit southern Indiana, the Lakeville Lions Club officers approved a \$1,000 donation to District 25-F to be used in Lions' efforts to help the communities hit by the tornado. District Governor Steve Winegardner applied for and received a \$10,000 disaster relief grant from LCIF. We collected \$80 at the Spaghetti Dinner that will also be sent to DG Steve.

March Dinner Meeting: Our guest speaker will be **Lion Dottie Flack**, the Lions Liaison and Patient Advocate in the Department of Radiation Oncology at the Indiana University Medical Center in Indianapolis. Lion Dottie has an outstanding presentation: **Cancer For The Curious**. We will learn the basics of cancer, staging, genetics, second opinions, therapies, side effects, clinical trials, survivorship, and care-givers. Expect a fun, educational presentation designed to provide new information.
