Volunteers from the Lakeville Lions Club, Lapaz Lions Club, and three local churches participated in the **La-Ville Summer Lunch Program**. Lunches were prepared at LaVille Elementary School and delivered to children at 7 locations in Lakeville and Lapaz. The Lakeville Lions Club delivered lunches every Monday during the five-week program, and 10 Lions and Lions family members participated in the project.

On the first day of the program, PDG Dave Court and PDG Paul Russell met a family that includes a deaf boy. After talking to the boy's mother, PDG Dave made arrangements for the boy to attend Deaf Camp at Camp Mack on a campership funded by the Indiana Lions Speech and Hearing project. If we had not participated in the Summer Lunch program, this boy would not have been able to attend Deaf Camp.
