A Message from the President Lion Sharon Feitz

Life is a series of challenges, how you will face them is how you will live your life. Please remember the family of **Lion Robert Newton**, who passed away on September 26, 2012. Our club is making a donation to **Newton Park** in his memory.

Please remember the family of **Lion Patricia Clark**, who passed away on October 13, 2012. Funeral arrangements are pending at Johnson-Danielson Funeral Home in Plymouth.

In the past month, our **Operation KidSight** vision screening team, assisted by Lions from other Lions Clubs in St. Joseph County, has provided free vision screenings for more than 700 children at Head Start programs in South Bend and other locations, at several area schools, and at two special events in South Bend. More than 80 of these children - nearly 12% - will be referred for follow-up exams. At some locations, the referral rate was nearly 18%. State-wide, the referral rate is 5-6%, so we apparently have many children in St. Joseph County who have vision problems. At the October board meeting, **Dictionary Project Chairman Lion Howard Heines** reported that the **Lake-ville Lions Club** and **Lapaz Lions Club** distributed dictionaries to 90 third-graders at **LaVille Elementary School**. Lion Howard shared some of the "Thank you" letters which the club received. Lion Howard will be sharing these letters with the Lapaz Lions Club at their monthly dinner meeting on Thursday, November 1st. If you are interested in participating in this visitation, please contact **Lion Sharon Feitz (784-8989)**. Our club distributed an additional 94 dictionaries to third-graders in four private schools on the south side of South Bend. These schools were previously served by the Center Township Lions Club, before that club folded. So far this year, approximately a dozen clubs in our district have distributed dictionaries to nearly 1200 third-graders.


